President's report/clubhouse (Laurie)

No report

Treasurer's Report (Candice)

- Report circulated prior to meeting
- CC explained breakdown of costs in relation to use of facilities, rising club costs etc., focussing on organisational membership for Camberwell and MLC in addition to school fees paid

Coaching (Greg)

Need to get something up on website about the upcoming coaching courses for summer –
don't want to plan courses for weekends where races will be on and lots of boats taken

- Greg will block out programs until April next year and start organising coaches to commit to these
- A particular individual wishes to become a member with a FOB and has demonstrated paddle competency but is not able to empty a boat safely. Greg has advised them to contact an INCC coach to observe this skill and sign off – she has yet to pay membership fees so this will need to be checked prior to handing out a FOB
- Geoff mentioned an enquiry from a 15 year old that is keen to join but is a beginner. Since
 there are no courses on at this time of year Greg suggested he can pay the fees for the
 Beginner's Course but is absorbed into the Sunday morning sessions (9-11am). This is not in
 preference to running a Beginner's Course, but is to meet the demand over the cooler
 months

Action: GK to send CC course dates to put on website

Boat Captain (Rob)

- Two boats with Lawrie being repaired
- Letters for Carol have been written but are not being sent until the boat stickers have been put on the boats and 'promo pics' have been taken

From previous: LC to get INCC boat stickers

Clubhouse Coordinator (Rob)

- Rob brought up existing issue of knocking walls out of back room and re-doing electrical wiring Candice suggested it is not wise for INCC to pay for action ourselves but there is the question of how many years will we have to wait until the council change the building to make it more useful for us. Council have obligations for "necessary maintenance" which isn't really wall-knocking. It might be worth INCC pushing for a partial payment (at least) by council to keep their attention drawn to the old club facilities. Rob estimates after-wall-knocking repairs and patches would be around \$5,500
- Rob is happy to do the strengthening work in the roof which doesn't require a lot of money spent. Difficult to know what to do here because the roof definitely needs to be done when the renovation happens, but they may not happen for a long time. Geoff suggests if we do things to improve storage then it's good, but if it's improving the building Ken suggests to leave it as a strategic method, though he objects to the principle of sitting around doing nothing when it needs doing. Rob suggests a vote as to whether to proceed or not proceed. Suggestion to get rid of the couch, move the ergo from the main room into the back room. Rob says there is no asbestos in the back room (despite stickers which say otherwise) so removal of rooms should be fine. Greg suggests the issue of the wiring really needs to come from the council, it is their maintenance and safety issue. Need to be careful any pushing doesn't make the council shut that end of the building entirely. Geoff suggests we need to work out what to do with the space before we start whacking walls. Rob to look at what we would do if we got the space, draw up some ideas and talk to the council again, Geoff to assist. Will revisit next meeting

Action: RG and GB to draw up some ideas for use of space at end of club and present at next meeting

- Cleared the blockage in ladies showers and new shower heads have been put in most cubicles. They are wonderful. Thank you Rob for getting on to this so promptly
- More sealing of ingress by the possums has been completed (doorway with fridge, bbq old storage area in corners and other side on that wall) – one more hole in ladies bathroom to be done next time
- Emptied old hot water service in prep for doing the work in the ceiling
- Tidy up of committee room is needed, Rob will create some shelves and hopefully we can get everything off the floors

Enrolment Officer/rack report (Geoff)

- Report circulated prior to meeting
- Geoff organised a hoist to get boats into high racks
- Double boat belonging to non-financial member was removed, the member has since renewed but as per the boat rules, they are now at the bottom of the waiting list to store this double
- Carried over from last meeting re: Canadian paddler membership refund after December, decision postponed to next meeting.
 - background: A Canadian paddler has joined INCC but is only here until December Geoff proposes to refund her less than 25% Of her membership once her visa expires in December.
