Special discussion – Clubhouse improvements

Brian Smith (project manager) attended from council. Under Disability Discrimination Act, Council is required to bring all buildings to 'specification' which includes providing access for people with a disability. Brian presented preliminary 'spec' plans which included ramped access to existing main entry, extension of front of clubhouse path south to join existing 'road', proposed accessible toilet facilities in old Caretakers area, and renewal of drainage system at front of clubhouse. Council is concerned with the building only, surrounding land is Parks and apparently Parks are not concerned about meeting access regulations.

Committee raised several immediate issues:

- Proposed ramp blocks access to double doors and renders majority of outdoor space difficult and unsafe to use (ie if navigating with boats)
- Making building accessible does not bring into consideration the users of the clubhouse nor the surrounding environment— and the purpose of the club being canoeing – and therefore illogical and a poor use of funds.
- Proposed use of caretakers would negate clubs plan to review boat storage with the preferred option of using this area to increase capacity

Therefore the Committee took the opportunity to raise profile of the clubs aims to improve facilities – including increase of storage. Described preferred options to Brian, also raised options such as open slab – roof of bunker.

Action: Brian to continue to work with his team at council to revise plans and meet again with committee in a month. (Brian then left)

Significant discussion followed. Committee frustrated by lack of consultation, lack of apparent disregard to the purpose of the club and disrespect to community members (who may have a disability – be able to get in the clubhouse but not be able to get to the water). Frustrations aside, the committee recognised that this was an opportunity to lobby council for the changes that would improve our facility. Candice and Lawrie to consider meeting with Stuart from Council to discuss.

President's report

- Marathon has instructed clubs to have two 'stand up banners' to erect at race meets. John Young has presented a design. CC offered to assist with design particularly around fonts, also to suggest double sided will contact John.
- Raised several boat related issues see Boat Captain report

Treasurer Report

- GB sought clarification on budget structure. (query was PDF related)
- CC has reviewed budget against previous year. Less income from coaching courses but more coaching cost (related to support of junior program and increase of coaches fees). Need to make sure that courses have enough people to make them worthwhile. Balancing out cost of running course and how much income they bring in, CC suggested that ideally to aim for a minimum of 8 people per course. Also raised that equivalent programs (such as CV come and try) are cheaper. Possible to consider an increase of coaching costs in the next financial year. LC also raised possibility of tapping into small grants to help offset costs. KG suggested if to raise fees need appropriate number of coaches (for quality experience). GK reinforced challenges of managing the beginners courses to make sure attendance rates consistent.

- LC mentioned has 2nd hand double minke for sale if club were interested.
