1. Attendees & Apologies

- 2. The meeting opened at 7:30. Due to Covid-19, social distancing was practiced and the meeting kept short, addressing only urgent items. President (Debbie Bennett)

Deb was absent (stuck in Lima, Peru) and no report.

<u>Clubhouse Development Subcommittee</u> (Debbie Bennett, Candice Charles, Rob Godwin)

Candice reported not much happening but will send an email to Committee members.

Clubhouse Co-ordinator (Lawrie Chenoweth)

Lawrie was absent (emergency electrical problem).

The schools have shut down sports programs.

→ Candice will get Lukas to clean the bunker one more time then stop until schools resume. Also agreed that he be given permission to buy any additional materials required by Covid-19.

The Working Bee set for Saturday 2nd May 10:30-12:30 was not discussed.

There are extra rubbish bins but putting them out is still an issue.

The Gym is to close.

Treasurer (Candice Charles)

Not discussed.

Boat Captain (Lawrie Chenoweth)

There have been further instances of non-compliant handling of club trailers.

Candice said any extra storage for trailers (e.g. prefab shed from Gasworks) would be part of overall redevelopment and there was no short term opportunity.

Geoff advised Paddle Vic have agreed to store the large trailer at Westerfolds.

- To meet Parks Victoria (their landlord) conditions, the trailer would be known as the Paddle Vic Marathon trailer (but INCC would retain ownership)
- It has to fit beside the existing "VIS" trailer and would have a small Melbourne Canoe Club trailer in front of it
- The trailer would need to be accessed in office hours (or by several PV / INCC officials who have a key)
- Others may use the trailer by agreement with INCC
- Geoff will dispose of an unserviceable PV trailer currently in the space
- ★ Geoff to communicate acceptance of the conditions to PV and then arrange to move the INCC trailer to Westerfolds

Geoff tabled a Boat Trailer Policy compiled in conjunction with Lawrie. It will now be updated to reflect the large trailer going to Westerfolds. Hannah and Geoff have differing opinions on how to best sling a boat on the trailer.

- One member assigned a temporary rack (until Marathon Nationals) in the private doubles area
- Club Boat # 14 ("Carol Osborn" K1) temporarily moved to rack B1
- One non-financial member removed her boat
- One additional Club K1 (low volume) added to an extended rack amongst Minkes
- We cannot keep stuffing in more Club boats. Creation of new racks impinges on usability of the Clubhouse and existing racks.
 We have more than enough Club boats some must be retired to create space if new boats are justified.
- There is some updating of racks records required, but I don't have the capacity to do this.
- There are still 2 old MLC K2's outside the clubhouse.

The above is a break down by GoMembership category (Club membership types of "Junior" and "MLC/CGS" are included in "Junior")

Junior numbers have increased with MLC adding many paddlers (but they are joined as general Juniors not "MLC/CGS").

All categories are still down on last year (except Volunteer).

We appear to have several non-members making regular use of our club. Members are reminded there is a limit of 3 visits as a guest. I propose we ask them to join our club.

I propose for 2020-21 INCC consider a "Non-affiliated" membership, i.e. the member is not a member of PV/PA.

- I understand other Clubs already do this
- I see no value in the PA/PV membership of \$95 per year for recreational paddlers:

- 24/7 personal accident insurance is unlikely to be used (it is last resort after private insurance and Medicare etc)
- 24/7 public liability third party personal injury and third party property insurance (it is unlikely paddlers will injure others or damage property while casually paddling on the Yarra)
- o Recreational paddlers, don't enter Club, State and National events
- o More info is available from other Facebook posts etc than from PA E-newsletters etc
- Recreational paddlers are not interested in access to pathways and opportunities to be selected in State and
 National representative teams and development squads which are heavily focused on Sprint and Slalom and not
 Marathon. I don't see that INCC member's PA/PV fees benefit our competitive Marathon paddlers.
- Those supporting the Club/PV/PA could be "Volunteer" members of PA for professional indemnity
- I propose the Senior "Non-affiliated" membership is \$50 less than affiliated membership (and the Club is \$45 better off per member and probably \$5,000 in total per year). The membership would give the same INCC rights to racks, use of Club boats etc.
- We could still run this via GoMembership (as we already do for Gym membership), but if PA block that, we could maintain our own basic (uncomplicated) Club membership system
- Those who compete, or otherwise wish to, would continue as affiliated members
- We could attract more Club members with a lower entry fee. If they subsequently want to compete, they can affiliate.
- PA is becoming increasingly adversarial (e.g. event fee for Come & Try and for Beginners courses with onerous registration; undercutting Clubs with Direct Membership; new waiver etc). I don't see that they have Recreational or Marathon paddlers' interests at heart. Most members would be better off without PA. INCC has already taken steps in this direction (e.g. running Learn to Paddle courses outside PA)
