  - We are in a good position despite being slightly from last year due to fewer grants.

Report from Steph (in absentia):

Learn to paddle course

- we have had plenty of interest with everyone looking to get back to activities after various lockdowns last year.
- we had to cancel the December 2020 course as there wasn't enough interest at the time
- both the course #2- Jan Sat and course #3 -Jan Sunday's went well and it was great to start up again
- Course #4 Feb Saturday's -was fully booked and we were suppose to finish last weekend but couldn't because of the snap lockdown this will finish in the next week or so
- course #5 March Saturday's is also booked out and almost ready to go (need a few assistant coaches to help)

Learn to paddle by private course

- there have been plenty of registrations for the private lessons as the other courses fill up or people want to get the course done quickly at a time that suits them (which after all is the whole idea).
- -the private courses have been more of a challenge to schedule as there was a big back log because people were registering last year when we were closed and we could even run their lessons. Other issues were after multiple emails to coaches there was not a lot of response (only 3 of the 17 coaches I emailed said they could take on a private course) and even after agreeing to run courses some coaches then backed out and replacements had to be found.

Understandably people are very busy over the December- Feb time of year especially now we can actually do activities; it just meant it took longer than usual to get through the ever growing wait list. | Overall going well- with the interest I will look at dates in April to run a last course of the season (after that it gets too cold for beginners to learn).

- 48 people have paid for the beginner courses, but a smaller number have gone through with their courses so we really need to get through more of these people ahead of April.
- Coaches on the committee noted some are available for week-night beginner courses to help with backlog of new paddlers.
- Committee noted there is a current shortage of coaches and that we could address this by contacting Paddle Victoria to organise a coaching course.

- We currently have 257 members, slightly down from 287 this time last year.
   This difference may not be real as we are yet to register Term 1 juniors and school paddlers.
- Candice will discuss registration with Michael (MLC) and Lachlan (CGS) at upcoming meeting on March 2<sup>nd</sup>.
- Candice noted the juniors will need to be registered ahead of the Vic Champs on Feb 27<sup>th</sup> & 28<sup>th</sup>.
- Noted that we have many new club members and would like to encourage a friendly culture at the club by welcoming these new people. This is aided by the Sunday doubles program that is being coordinated by Sally.

## • Racking Co-Ordinator (Candice Charles)

- Planning to replace labels on racks during upcoming working bee and identify boats that are in the wrong spots.

## • Communications Co-ordinator (Brianna Jones)

- Rachel has offered to assist with newsletter proofing, Candice is happy with Rachel being the newsletter proof reader prior to distribution.
- Discussion regarding how we can market our newsletters more effectively (timing and frequency), particularly for race emails that are less frequently engaged with.
- Bri will be creating a content calendar that will indicate when communication will be released.

- Sally asked if she should be promoting club races in the members Facebook group:

- Discussed importance of communicating information regarding club trailers and boat transport with particular emphasis on the Vic Champs.
- Debbie flagged the location for the Vic Champs may be changed given a series of issues on the rowing course this will be dependent on whether the Australian championships is being held in March.

- Sally has started a Google Drive for the event and begun to update the documents for the 2021 event.

- Candice has updated the INCC 2021 handbook and updated wording about life jackets and club access. Flagged that, for security reasons, the club is automatically locked between 12pm – 5am. Members who would like to access the club during these hours can contact Candice and she will grant them access.
- Noted that we have lost a number of PFDs and will require more.
- Proposal for adoption of the use of collaboration tool by the committee for communication (Slack) – Deferred to next meeting
- Discussion of pop-up bike lane on Heidelberg Rd:
  - We had received an email from Paul van der Sluys regarding the disruption to parking caused by the pop up bike lane on Heidelberg Rd.
  - Councillor Amanda Stone had asked Candice about the impact on the club
  - Noted that we need to manage parent drop-off for junior programs better. We should emphasise they use the round-about rather than filling the car-park.
  - Decision made to avoid making a public stance on the issue and for Candice to suggest use of the Melbourne Polytechnic carpark with Amanda Stone and council.
- Lawrie has had a request to use our club C1 outside of the club. This was approved by the committee.
- Private come and try request from the people who did our signage. This will involve approx 6-8 people, Lawrie looking for another coach who can help.
   Coaches on the committee suggested they could assist and we have proposed hosting the come and try 2-4pm March 21<sup>st</sup>.
