Now that nationals has been cancelled, we hope to get more paddlers along to the Frank Harrison. Club race attendees may be interested in the PV races and this may be an avenue for increasing overall race participation.

- Uniform Co-ordinator (Stephanie Langley and Debbie Bennett).Deb has emailed the committee with new designs and would like feedback by the end of next week.
- Safety Co-ordinator (Isaac Johnson, assisted by Anthony Cross)
 Anthony has purchased two updated first aid kits to replace the expired first aid supplies. Anthony has suggested that we should have a notebook (or similar) to help notify us when supplies have been used.
 Defibrillator is still working and we should ensure that we have a service agreement.
 Anthony has offered to run a first aid information session for club members. This session could include the use of the defibrillator. The committee suggested that this is not currently required.

6. General Business

Proposal – Expansion of junior program (https://www.dropbox.com/scl/fi/nr6bwtlu21suievefn5w6/Junior-Program-Exansion-Proposal.docx?dl=0&rlkey=4xfm5ek4jao2qhsn4ra1fcxlq)

 Committee approved that we should start by adding one extra session on Wednesdays. Committee has suggested that selection criteria for the additional session should be lowered. Committee has suggested that a cap may not be required.

Review of Beginner Course fees for private lessons (Stephanie Langley)

- Identified that currently private courses are \$150 regardless of whether it is one or two people. When you have two people, it costs less than two people in the group course.
- Steph has proposed that we should clearly state on the website that both people should pay \$150. This will encourage people into the group courses if they can.
- Candice also suggested that we update the wording on the website to say that the private sessions are three 1.5hr sessions.
- Candice suggested if you have a private course alone then you get three 1.5hr sessions for \$200.
- Committee has approved a new structure of 1 person \$200, 2 people \$300. Session lengths are 2hr in week 1 and 1hr in subsequent weeks.

New uniform design

- Committee asked to provide feedback by the end of the week.
- Suggestion that we should add the logo to the back of the paddling top as some people will wear this before/after the race.

Proposal for adoption of the use of collaboration tool by the committee for communication (Slack)

- Sally to begin using Slack with some subcommittees and this will gradually expand throughout the committee.

Candice met with Michael (MLC) and Lachlan (CGS) recently.

- New options for payment and boat sharing with our junior were discussed and this will be discussed again ahead of the next financial year.

Lawrie's hairy bikers group will have a come and try session next year.
