### Club racing proposal:

Discussed potential for prizes to be community based - e.g. Voucher for meal at Grandview. Committee in agreement that second race style option is best fit, also think selection from two different pools and random pairings good, especially early on. May eventually pair novices together. Committee all happy for club to cover cost of BBQ.

#### Paddle audit:

Committee agreed to swap from just focussing on paddle room to do a more general working bee

- Need to confirm how many members the club is allowed to have inside but probably not too much of an issue because can move many jobs outside.
- Sunday 7/3 agreed as date for working bee + bbq. Probably to start at 11:30am
- Communication to members required. Steph suggested we highlight that new members can come, no need for special skills.
- Need INCC stickers for new boats.
- Candice will start setting up labels for racks. Try to rearrange so all club boats together so members know full extent of boats available.
- Working Bee identified as opportunity to get boats out of rafters.

# 6. Reports:

- **President** (Debbie Bennett)
  - Deb absent, report to be circulated via email.
- Clubhouse Development Subcommittee (Debbie Bennett, Candice Charles, Rob Godwin)
  - No change on redevelopment, have heard nothing.
- Treasurer (Anthony Cross)
  - Candice submitted Treasurer's report because Anthony is away. Compared to this time last year, club has made greater profit - similar income but net profit much higher. Coaching programs largely responsible for this.
  - ~180 senior members, 50 juniors (35x MLC, registered late 2020) slowly returning to pre-covid numbers. Fairly steady stream of new members, lots of orientations.
- Clubhouse Co-ordinator (Lawrie Chenoweth)
  - There has been some pooling of water in men's changeroom. Lawrie to report to Council for them to resolve.
- Boat Captain (Lawrie Chenoweth)
  - Replacing new boats next step. Lawrie has had interest from people looking to buy second hand TK1s.
  - o ACTION: Lawrie to determine what can be replaced.
  - Bri suggested ML size K2
  - o Lawrie says some 6 paddles are coming.
  - Some MLC paddles can be taken (some have already been moved to clubhouse)
     need to be relabelled as INCC.
- Coaching (Stephanie Langley)
  - Adult Beginners
  - Juniors
  - o Intermediate
  - Advanced Coaching

Courses are fully booked until March. Candice had raised suggestion of adding another course given significant interest. Trying to find a time probably difficult but possibility of twilight weeknight course.

- Membership Co-ordinator (Candice Charles)
  - Lots of new members.
- Racking Co-Ordinator (Candice Charles)
  - Waiting list for racks under control, only one waiting really.
- Communications Co-ordinator (Brianna Jones)
  - Hoping to make some material (videos from School champs, etc.) to use in promotional ads to attract new members in partnership with Sam Glynn (previous MLC paddler). Unsure as yet if she would want to be paid.
  - Are there any other club members who would have skills we can capitalise on?
     Candice says newish member with graphic design art skills (some animation?)
     who might be interested. To pass on details to Bri.
  - Bri wanting to send out survey for members to determine how they would best like to be communicated with (e.g. Emails, social media, etc)
  - 'This Girl Can' govt initiative week where they will publicise community events (22-28/3)

Come and Try day - expand to 'open day' for club - e.g. To capture those who
might not be dressed appropriately but are interested to look around

#### Social Coordinator (Sally Miller)

- Need to add BBQs discussed above (working bee, club races).
- Easter camp option Bri suggested focus on communities that were affected by bushfires - i.e. Gippsland or Lake Tyers
- Aiming for two Come and Try days late 2021 feedback to run them as adult + junior for both, rather than separate.
- Committee present decided preference for in person AGM rather than virtual (e.g. Zoom) if possible.
- Happy with proposals from Sally

# • Race Participation Co-ordinator (Penny Young)

- Little success with encouraging newer/less experienced members to come to formalised races. Current summer racing calendar less ideal for starting newer paddlers (age/gender based so set distances rather than divisional/with options for reduced distance).
- Need to try targeting members more directly appears social media + emails on a broader level not very effective at attracting different paddlers.
- Will focus on drawing paddlers to club races first. Can then build on this to bring them to Winter Series/other Paddle Vic races.
- o Possibility to use club races as a chance for 'race skills' session too.
- Lawrie asked whether we have ever surveyed proportion of club members that are competitive or wanting to be competitive. Answer is we have not officially done so, should follow this up.
- Suggested some kind of club event every couple of months not competition based. To be held in different locations - e.g. Paddle to City, paddle on a different river/Lilydale
- Should we set up a 'recreation' portfolio/coordinator? May not necessarily need to be an official committee member
- Race Host Co-ordinator (Sally Miller, Brianna Jones)
- Uniform Co-ordinator (Stephanie Langley).
- Safety Co-ordinator (previously Hannah Scott to be taken over by Isaac Johnson?)
